- **4. Public Participation -** Donna Tristram attended meeting in role as newly appointed Clerk to the parish and introduced herself to the councillors and looked forward to working with them.

- **a.** Free Tree and Shrub Give-away with Salt bag give-away and CBC Winter Resilience Project: APPROVED to cancel event due to current situation. Plan to rearrange in same format for November to co-incide with National Tree Week.
- **b. Stanway in Bloom: APPROVED** preliminary budget of £500.00 to spend on summer bulbs for planting on land managed by SPC. Ideas for which species to be circulated. Plans for further bulb planting around parish in autumn. Councillors will undertake further investigation for possible places for planters.
- **c. Defibrillators:** Two confirmed locations at Stanway Post Office and Stanway Rovers and one installed. Permission from CBC to attach one to streetlight near Halstead Road if it is owned and managed by SPC. Cllr. Williams to investigate specific columns with SPC inventory. **NOTED.**
- **d. Woodland Project:** SPC officially greenest parish in Colchester. CBC has now suspended project until pandemic restrictions are relaxed. Less damage to new plants. If problem continues a letter should be sent to local schools **NOTED.**

- **a. Annual Parish Forum: APPROVED** to provisionally plan for the event on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> May. Chair to confirm award letter for Needing Help volunteers. Cllr. Norton suggested a speaker from Stanway Foodbank.
