TERMS OF REFERENCE

COMMUNITY SERVICES EVENT WORKING GROUP

Working groups or 'task-and-finish' groups are set up for a short-term purpose. They are not subject to the strict rules that apply to formal council meetings and do not need to be held in public. A working group cannot make a decision on behalf of the council but can explore options and present these to the relevant committee for any necessary decisions. Operating procedures will be as follows:

- No delegated authority or decision-making power.
- Not subject to LGA 1972 requirements can expediate action.
- No Agendas or Minutes, just a record of action points.
- Clear setting of the task and scope for the WG
- Appoint Lead and members of WG to research, investigate, consider.
- Can meet anytime, by any means.
- WG reports monthly to committee with a final report/recommendation/event as closure of WG.
- Clear time frame for WG should not last longer than 6 months or there is a known end date.
