i/ a 20mph speed zone/limit on Peace Road, Stanway and the roads off Peace Road, between its junction with Lucy Lane South and Halstead Road



ii/ a 20mph speed zone/limit on Cornflower Road, which would also include Cowslip Court and Centaury Close



If the above requests for the 20mph are supported Essex County Council would need to consider it through the LHP Scheme Validation process. This is where a design engineer looks at the issues raised, as well as any suggested solution and puts forward feasible engineering solutions, where possible, to the issues raised.

iii/ The Essex County Council (Burton Way, Dyers Road Development, Stanway) (20mph Zone). Following planning approval of the development ECC is proposing to implement a 20mph zone to reduce vehicular speeds and improve road safety for residents and pedestrians. The new housing estate roads are constructed to ensure, as far as possible, that vehicle speeds are at or below 20mph. This is done via the introduction of a 20mph zone and a variety of physical measures which include road tables and ramp from its junction with Laurence Byrne Avenue, north westerly, then northerly for approximately 177 metres.

This order conforms to Essex County Council Policy including the Essex Design Guide and Essex Speed Management Strategy, and as contained within the Highways Act 1980 Section 38 Agreement.
