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## **Public Consultation**

The Parish Council is currently preparing its budget for 2022 and has several exciting projects planned, including the upgrade of our two play areas on Silverwitch Green and at Lucy Lane South. These will compete for funding against other substantial projects like the new Community Centre being leased to SPC by the Borough Council, the acquisition of the two parks mentioned above from CBC, plus a considerable number of smaller ones.

The Council's preference is to finance all this from its own resources, rather than a substantial increase in its Precept. One way of making its money go further is to apply for grants and/or to apply for a loan from the Public Works Loan Body (PWLB), a government agency that provides low-cost loans to councils across the country. One of the requirements for the latter (and often for grants) is to undertake a consultation with local residents to take into accounts their views when considering new projects.

So saying, we wish to hear your views on the refurbishment funding of the two play areas. The total cost of the two will be around £110,000 and we sent out requests to tender to seven reputable companies, two of which eventually submitted a formal bid and from these, the contractor was chosen and the designs agreed. Works are scheduled to start early next year on the agreed refurbishment plans.

The questions we'd like you to answer are limited, because this is a replacement rather than brand new project, and are as follows:
