

Notes for the BURIAL GROUND SUB-COMMITTEE JUNE 2020

The following decisions were made under the Council's own emergency protocols agreed at its Extraordinary Meeting of March 18th 2020. This means that, after email/telephone discussion, any decision was made formally by the Chair of the (Sub-) Committee (as an appointed, unpaid officer) and the Clerk.

- 1. Agreed that there would be no July Meeting of the Burial Ground Sub Committee as it is the day of Trevor's Funeral. Business will continue to be conducted by telephone and email.
- 2. The internment for Trevor Manning is at 11am on Tuesday 7th July. Plot AB1-8 to be marked on by Colin Lax on the 5th July.
- 3. The internment for Patricia Andrews has been put on hold until family from overseas can attend.
- 4. Internment for Mr David Holland on 2pm on 12th June went smoothly.
- 5. The water supply to the Burial Ground will be available from the 20^{th} July.
- 6. Catherine in contact with CBC regarding free trees for Comb Meadow which will be permitted species only and preferably ones that blossom at some stage. CBC will survey site and deliver trees. We will have to arrange planting and watering.
