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Other considerations:

- 1. Application A for works to be made to Essex Highways (6-8 weeks for permission)
- 2. Application 20 to Essex Highways to install a new bus shelter
- 3. Removal of bus stop sign and have signs attached to bus shelter
- 4. Placement of planters each side of bus stop to enhance rural setting (Application to be made to Essex Highways and costs to be investigated)
- 5. To take over responsibility of litter bin at bus stop
- 6. Kessel Curb (grants available once application approved)
- 7. Traffic control costs involved. Traffic management company confirmed that the works will need to have a 2 way traffic system whilst the works go on.
